

NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

The Hayden Lake Irrigation District (HLID) (OWNER) is requesting written Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from Idaho licensed public works contractors who are interested in being pre-qualified to submit competitive bids for the **2.0 Million Gallon Water Tank Project** pursuant to Idaho Code 67-2805(2)(b) "Procurement of Public Works Construction" Category B Competitive Bidding. The OWNER will prequalify prospective bidders for the construction project on the criteria set forth herein.

The Project generally consists of construction of a new 2.0 Million Gallon composite elevated water tank, connections to the existing water system, site piping, site grading, landscaping, and frontage improvements.

The Request for SOQ consists of this Notice, Instructions for Prequalification of Bidders, and a Statement of Qualifications Form. Prospective bidders must submit a response in the format outlined. Any response may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled time below for the opening of the responses or authorized postponement thereof. Copies of the SOQ documents shall be obtained by contacting Katie Halland at J-U-B ENGINEERS, Inc. at (208) 762-8787 during normal business hours or emailing khalland@jub.com. By requesting a copy from J-U-B ENGINEERS, prospective bidders will be included on an SOQ list, thereby allowing subsequent notification if addenda are issued.

One electronic PDF copy of the completed SOQ and required forms must be received by Jon Baune (jbaune@jub.com) prior to **2:00 PM Pacific Daylight Time on March 25th, 2020**. To be considered, the submission must consist of one complete signed submission; partial submittals or submittals in several parts are not allowed. SOQs shall be formatted to fit on 8.5" x 11" pages. Late or incomplete submissions will not be accepted. File size shall be less than 10 MB. Respondents are encouraged to call Jon Baune at (208) 762-8787 to verify receipt of submittal. The email subject line shall read as follows:

All responses must be signed and the prospective bidders shall be licensed in accordance with Idaho Code 54-1902. Upon receipt of SOQs, the OWNER will evaluate and determine which prospective bidders are qualified to bid. If the OWNER proceeds with bidding the project, all prequalified bidders deemed qualified by the OWNER will be invited to submit formal bids for the project in accordance with the Bidding Documents (currently under development).

HLID, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to the advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises as defined at 49 CFR Part 23 will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex in consideration for an award.

Any protest of determination of qualifications or bidding procedures will be handled in accordance with procedures delineated in Idaho Code 67-2805. Written objections to prequalification procedures must be received by Jon Baune as agent of Hayden Lake Irrigation District at least three (3) business days before the date and time upon which submissions are due.

Prospective bidders will be responsible for all costs (including site visits, if any) incurred in preparing or responding to this Request for Qualifications. All materials and documents submitted in response to this RFQ become the property of HLID and will not be returned.
