ENCROACHMENT VIOLATION NOTICE

Dear District Member:

You are receiving this Encroachment Violation Notice because the above identified encroachments were placed within the District's water line right-of-way. Pursuant to Hayden Lake Irrigation District Bylaw provision 6.2, you have 30 days from the date of this notice to remove the identified encroachment(s). If not removed, the District may remove them at your expense. Alternatively, the District may discontinue water service to the address of the property where the encroachment(s) exist until such time as the encroachment is removed.

If you disagree regarding the existence of the encroachment(s), you have fourteen (14) days from the date of notice to file an appeal to the Board or Directors of the Hayden Lake Irrigation District. The Board will schedule a hearing for you to consider the District's file regarding the encroachment(s), and to consider any evidence you wish to present regarding the encroachment(s). The Board will then issue a written decision on whether the above-identified encroachments exist.
