## **Notice Northside Shut-Off**

The District is planning two water shut offs in the near future for the area north of Hayden Avenue. The first shut-off will start on Wednesday April 21st, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. We expect the outage period to be approximately 30 minutes. The shut-off process will begin at 10:00 a.m. and should be done by 12:00 p.m. that day. The shut-off will be in stages but will occur during the two-hour window. This shut-off may be an inconvenience but should not take long. The purpose of this shut-off is to ensure all water valves are working properly, and hold tight, in the 27" waterline, in preparation for a major shut off scheduled for May 6th, 2021.

The major shut-off will require the District to cut the watermain and drain the 27" waterline to add additional valves and reroute water from an old line we wish to abandon to a new line on Lacey Avenue. The additional valves will allow the District to continue work in the area without having to shut off the water supply to numerous customers at one time. These additions and the new line are critical to the District infrastructure. The major shut-off will occur on May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and will begin at 3:00 p.m. This shut off will be for a minimum of 10 hours. Please plan ahead. The District would strongly suggest you have potable water handy for drinking and bathroom purposes. We would also suggest you have water set aside for plumbing purposes. Please refer to our website or Facebook page for up-to-date information.

In preparation of the shut-off, the District would request you turn off all faucets, hose bibs, and sprinkler systems and ensure all hoses are off the ground. Please make sure your backflow device is working properly. The District will be flushing a major line and it is imperative we avoid a possible backsiphonage situation to protect the water system.

The District appreciates your patience and understanding. District staff will be available to answer questions from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, up until the day of the outage. The District technicians will not be available the day off the shut-off as they will be preparing for the big job. We do apologize for this inconvenience.
