Public comment:

Mr. Kerr made a recommendation to the Board to terminate Alan Miller and offer him a severance package. Mr. Kerr feels Mr. Miller is not meeting the District's needs.

New Business:

- 1. Country Hollow: Steve with Tri-State Engineering spoke with the Board about the will serve. Country Hollow cannot final plat and get building permits due to the way the will serve from the District is worded. He would like to find a solution and have an updated will serve provided by Thursday so Country Hollow can be put on the City of Hayden's agenda. After much discussion a motion was made by Director Eifler to direct administrator to work with Steve @ Tri-State Engineering to draft a revised will serve letter, seconded by Chairman Timmins, passed.
- 2. **Stan Craft**: Chairman Timmins received an email from the mayor of Hayden about the fire flows and potential liability for the District if a fire broke out at Stan Craft. The administrator explained Stan Craft has always had fire flow from the two hydrants on the parcel. The new fire hydrants on the bare land along Atlas were off until the easement was signed and filed with the County, and the line was flushed and samples taken. The easement has been filed and water sampling completed. Water is on to the new fire hydrants.

Unfinished Business:

- New Well Construction: Electrical Bid is out for advertisement; building permit and design is ready and once the
 application is filled out Chairman Timmins will take to the city of Hayden. The board would like to hire a builder for the
 new well house.
